

Interschool chess league 2016

Campbelltown library teams Registration form

Each year dozens of schools compete in teams against each other to be named best A, B and C Grade chess team in South Australia. This is being organised by the South Australian Junior Chess League (SAJCL). Each team plays in a section against other schools. The best team of each section is invited to play at the state finals in September. A team consists of 4 players and play every fortnight on a Friday afternoon at 4pm in term 2 and 3. Games normally last between 30 minutes and 1 hour, with a maximum of 30 minutes allocated to each player per game.

Campbelltown library teams are eligible to play in this school league with students that fall in the following categories:

1. The school the student attends does not have a chess team
2. The student did not qualify for the school chess team (e.g. age or skill restrictions)

The following criteria apply for a student to be eligible for registration:

1. The student needs to be able to be present on each competition date at 3:45pm.
2. If a student is unable to attend a competition date – three days’ notice needs to be given.
3. The student needs to attend the weekly Campbelltown chess club throughout term 2 and 3.
4. The student needs to have a chess step-by-step workbook and perform homework if requested.
5. A yellow coloured shirt needs to be purchased and worn during each competition round.
6. No school uniform may be worn while playing for the community team.
